This report details from the SSMU legislative council meeting of September 27, 2018, that may concern MSS members. - The Executive Director, Brittany Williams, of the **Legal Information Clinic of McGill University** explains that the organization prioritizes student advocacy and the offering of legal services to McGill students. The legal advice they offer is specific to the province of Quebec. This service is free. Students can be accompanied to the *Regie du logement*, for example. They can also hire lawyers to assess confidential material.
- The director of the **McGill Office of Sustainability**, Francois Miller, along Sustainability Projects Fund (SPF) Steward, Krista Houser, explain that the role of the office is to steward the SPF that students are contributing to. The office is the flagship program to dedicate sustainability at McGill through various projects.
- SSMU president, Tre Mansdoerfer, explains that SSMU is currently installing 20 new **free menstrual products dispensers** throughout the campus.
