## How does it work

Preferential voting is a system of voting in which voters indicate their first, second, and lower choices of several candidates for a single office. If no candidate receives a majority, the second choices are added to the first choices until one candidate has a majority.

### VOTE

Please rank the candidate in order of preference

- 2 Gunner McGun
- 3 Tina Tryinghard
- 1 Peter Parkinson
- 4 Jenfaistrop Michaud

### PROCESS

Count voters' first choice

Does a candidate have majority?

**Winner**

Distribute eliminated candidate's ballots

Eliminate last place candidate



## How not to lose my vote

Rank every candidate according to your preferences

OR

Rank candidates you want and then use the chair (non-confidence vote) **ONCE**

**Do not** rank a candidate twice

**Do not** rank the same position twice

**Do not** put the chair twice
